Can a universal power adapter fit a Cameroon outlet?

Universal power adapters usually come with multiple plug types and can be adjusted to fit Cameroon outlets and many others. If your devices are not compatible with the voltage in your destination country, a voltage converter or transformer will also be necessary to convert the voltage to the appropriate range for your devices.

Do I need a power adapter in Cameroon?

If your devices are compatible with these specifications, you will not need a power adapter. However, if your devices use a different plug type or are not compatible with the voltage in Cameroon, you will need a power adapter and/or a voltage converter/transformer.

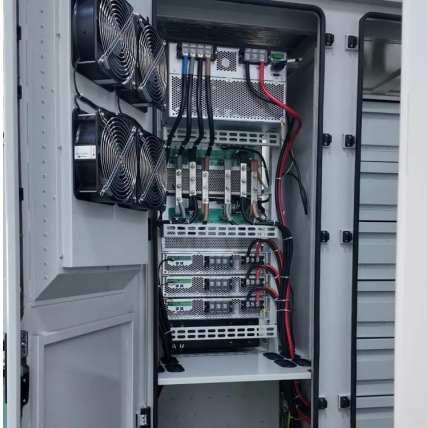
What type of plug does Cameroon use?

Cameroon uses power outlets and plugs of types C & E. Take a look at the pictures below to see what these plugs and power sockets look like: Do the outlets look different in your country?

You'll need a power plug adapter. Type C - The standard European plug. Commonly used in Europe, South-America and Asia, but also in quite a few other countries.

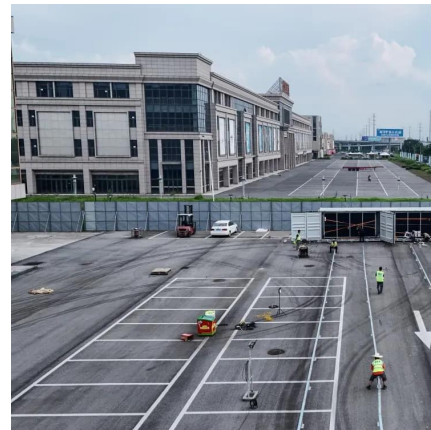
